How does the hound handle being crated?

He crates fine while we're gone. I give him a treat and a Kong with frozen peanut butter; he goes right in and lays down.

What does the hound enjoy?

Going for walks, playing with stuffed toys, and being petted. He does enjoy laying on the couch. He has gotten on our bed, but 99% of the time has been fine with sleeping all night on a dog bed in our bedroom.

Does the hound have any fears?

He seems a little afraid of having his teeth brushed—we're working on it in baby steps.

What type of temperament does the hound have? (Shy, outgoing, confident, etc.)

He does not seem to be an overly confident dog. He seems a little unsure of himself or a little nervous sometimes, but I think a lot of that is because he has gone through leaving the home he was previously in and having to adjust to being in a new place. He is confident in asking for pets (will nudge your hand), and confident in wanting to lay on the couch in the living room. He is not a great eater - a lot of the time he doesn't finish his food. I have only been giving him 1.5 cups at a time to see if he would actually eat all of his food, and he doesn't always finish even that much.

How does the hound handle new situations?

He acts somewhat hesitant, but quickly overcomes the hesitancy if we are confident. He seems to look at us and/or our hound to see how we're reacting and picks up on that.
