He has a pretty standard routine. He typically wakes between 5:30–6:00 AM and lets us know when he's ready to go outside in the morning. He goes out again right before bed (usually around 10:00–11:00 PM) and holds it well overnight. He will reliably wake you up if he needs to go out during the nightn by pacing or being restless. Or will whine when crated.

He sometimes needs encouragement to enter, but he settles nicely once inside. He can become vocal if he hears household activity. We do use a muzzle and belly band for crating, which have been effective at preventing chewing and accidents.

What does the hound enjoy?

Lenny loves being outside and enjoys spending time in the yard playing with a ball or pull toy while following me around. He is great at entertaining himself and often gets fun afternoon zoomies. He also loves going on walks and car rides, and he settles nicely in the car.

Does the hound have any fears?

Loud sudden noises/movement. Like if a broom falls over or something unexpected startles him, he will react. Did fine in a recent thunderstorm. I can't recall at this time if he's reactive to fireworks. Seems unfazed by cars on walks.

What type of temperament does the hound have? (Shy, outgoing, confident, etc.)

Lenny is a goofy, affectionate boy who loves attention. He's a fantastic cuddler who enjoys digging his face into your lap, lying right next to you on the floor, and staying close to see what you're doing — especially if something fun or exciting might be happening.
